

Information obligation for camera recordings

2. The purpose of the processing of personal data, for which the personal data are intended, as well as the legal basis for the processing of personal data:

Purpose: protection of life, health and property of persons and the operator and detection of crime

Legal basis:

The Controller processes the personal data of the data subject, namely the recording of the physical form and manifestations of the natural person, within the meaning of Article 6 (1) (f) of the Regulation and Section 13 (1) (f) of the Personal Data Protection Act (the processing of personal data is necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interests of the Controller or a third party, except in cases where these interests are outweighed by the interests or rights of the data subject requiring the protection of personal data). The legitimate interest is the protection of the property of the operator and its employees and the protection of the life and health of employees. In accordance with the principle of proportionality, the Operator has concluded that the protection of the Operator's property (to prevent thefts occurring on the Operator's premises) and its employees and other affected persons and the protection of the life and health of employees and other affected persons (the Operator authentically and continuously evaluates possible risks to the life and health of employees from the point of view of Act No. 124/2006 Coll. on Occupational Health and Safety by monitoring its premises) prevails over the in the interest of protecting the privacy of the data subject, namely the processing of audio/video recordings of the physical form and expressions of the data subject. The life and health of employees outweigh the interest in protecting the privacy of the person concerned. The Operator processes the audio/video recording of the physical form and the speech of the data subject for a maximum period of 14 days, while strictly adhering to the technical

and organizational measures adopted by the Operator. This retention period is necessary, as the operator, after detecting theft on his premises, will provide the record to law enforcement authorities to detect the crime and ensure remediation. After the expiry of the period of 14 days, the operator shall dispose of this record. Only a person authorized by the operator has access to such a recording or monitoring by a camera system, based on strict compliance with all instructions given to him by the operator. For this purpose, the operator has taken technical and organizational measures on the use of the camera system.

3. Identification of the recipient or category of recipient, if any

State institutions for the purpose of fulfilling the obligations of the controller:

Law enforcement authorities and courts.

4. Personal data retention period

Personal data obtained through the operator's camera system is stored for a maximum period of 14 days.

5. Rights of the data subject

The data subject has the right to:

- **request access to personal data** relating to the data subject;

As a data subject, you have the right to be provided with a list of personal data that we have available from you as well as information on how we process your personal data.

- **to rectify personal data,**

We have taken steps to keep your personal data accurate, complete and up-to-date. If you believe that the personal data we hold about you is not accurate, complete and up to date, please let us know.

- **to delete personal data,**

As a data subject, you can also ask us to delete your personal data if the reasons stated by law are met, e.g. if the purpose of processing has already ended.

- **to restrict the processing of personal data,**

As a data subject, you can ask us to stop using your personal data if we meet the legal conditions, e.g. if you believe that your personal data that we store is inaccurate, etc.

- **object to the processing of personal data,**

As a data subject, you have the right to object to the processing of your data, if you have become convinced that we do not have a legal basis for the processing of personal data; e.g. if our legitimate interests in processing personal data do not override the rights or interests of the data subject.

- **to the portability of personal data;**

As a data subject, you have the right, under certain circumstances, to request us to transfer the personal data you have provided to us. However, this right to portability only applies to personal data that we have provided to us on the basis of your consent or on the basis of a contract to which you are a party.

- **withdraw consent;**

As a data subject, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time in cases where we process your personal data on the basis of your consent.

- **file a motion to initiate proceedings or a complaint** with a supervisory authority;

The Operator shall handle the data subject's request in relation to the above-mentioned rights within the statutory time limits.
